- Working on animal welfare;
- Work experience as advocate for minimum five years at State/UT level;
- Age between 30-60 years
- Preference for honorary advocate.

The State/UT co-ordinator will look after all the legal matters in their respective High Court for various legal matters including preparation and filing of various legal documents in the Court, following the required procedure and taking necessary action, suing and defending the case on behalf of the Board and for appearance before the various Hon'ble Courts including Hon'ble High Court in their respective states and UTs.

Terms and Conditions for State/UT coordinators

1. State Co-coordinators will coordinate with concerned State Government Departments.
2. Will coordinate with AWBI District coordinators and Legal coordinators.
3. Will represent AWBI in State Boards and Department.
4. Will conduct inspections on the direction of AWBI wherever needed in the State along with District coordinators and other AWBI Nominees
5. Work for the formation and working of SPCAs in the Districts of the State.
6. Will work as resource person to assist AWOs for AWBI Scheme time to time.
7. Will organize and plan meetings visit of Chairman and other officials as and when required.
8. Will work to restrict cruelty to animals in general and entertaining the complaints/information received from animal lovers and also routed by AWBI and report the action to the Board.
9. Will attend specially designed State coordinator training programme of AWBI on his own cost as and when intimated.
10. He will submit Activity Report on quarterly basis to AWBI.
11. He is not allowed to misuse the AWBI name and will not indulge in any activity against State and Central Government and AWBI.
12. He is not allowed to accept from any AWO or Government agencies any donation, contribution, monitoring of any other benefit whatsoever for him and for the organizations with which he is associated as a member or office bearer or to improve his business, profession or organization by using his position as State coordinator or AWBI's name.
