The Board mandate of the Regional Sub-Committee Co-opted Members will be as under:-

- a) To arrange meeting with State Government Administrative Authorities or activation of State Animal Welfare Boards (SAWBs), District SPCAs and State Police Authorities for implementation of Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act and Rules made there under:-
- b) Reporting to the Law enforcement agencies (Police/SPCAs) of instances of animal abuse, and to represent as AWBI's authorized agents wherever required.
- c) Create awareness in schools and the civic society on humane treatment of animals through lectures, distribution of literature etc., and to encourage and love to animals.
- d) Organize meetings/seminars of NGOs of the region and to impress upon the AWOs/NGOs to follow best practices on animal welfare in their respective shelters.
- e) To initiate action against the infliction of unnecessary pain or suffering to animals and to promotion of animal welfare in general.
- f) To assist AWBI in getting timely UCs for the grants from AWOs/NGOs as and when required.
- g) All co-opted members are required to forward to the Board a summary of their Animal Welfare related activities performed by them in a quarterly basis. Please ensure that this is done without fail.
